

Revised HFDFW COVID Policy effective May 1, 2022.

Honor Flight DFW continues to prioritize the health and safety of all veterans by following Center for Diseases Control and Prevention (CDC) Guidelines.

COVID Vaccination/Testing

HFDFW will not require proof of vaccination or negative COVID test for participation in an Honor Flight trip.

CDC recommendations:

According to the CDC, COVID-19 vaccines are available in the United States and are effective at protecting people from getting seriously ill, being hospitalized, and even dying. As with vaccines for other diseases, people who are up to date are protected best. CDC recommends that everyone ages 5 years and older get their primary series of COVID-19 vaccine, and everyone ages 12 years and older also receive a booster shot. <https://www.cdc.gov>

Masks

Masks must be worn as required by federal or local policy/ordinance. Additionally, masks must be worn in any venue or business that requires a mask. It continues to be strongly recommended that unvaccinated individuals be encouraged to wear a mask, especially in close settings, while on an Honor Flight trip or event.

CDC Recommendations:
